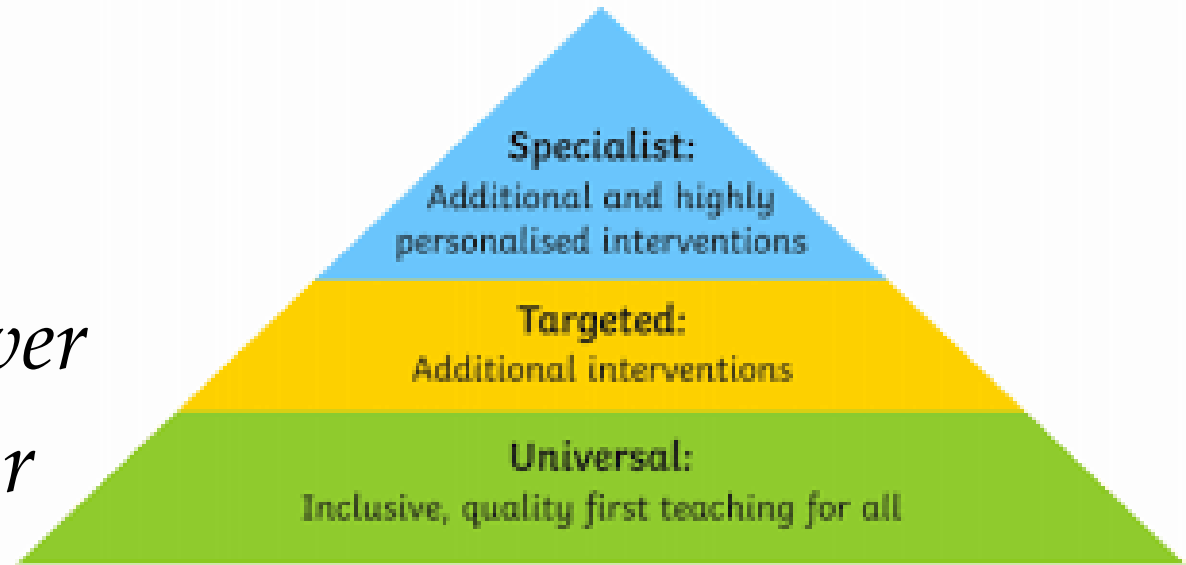

Universal support (Quality First Teaching)

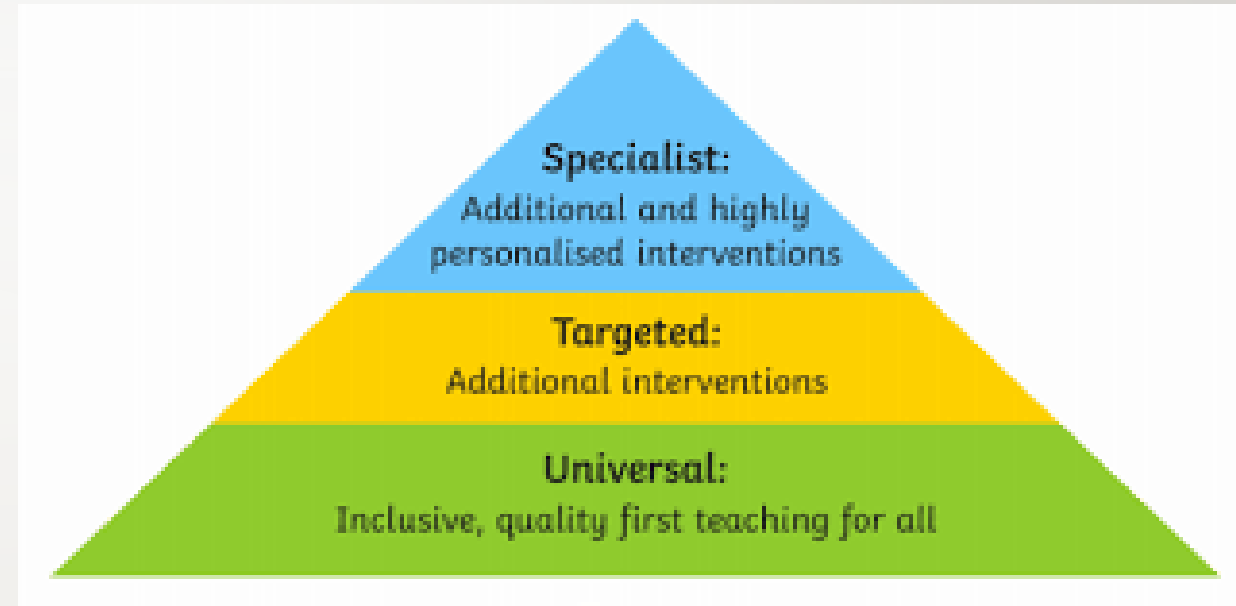
