Updates

**Library Project.** The library furniture has arrived but we are still waiting for the carpet to be delivered and installed. We have commissioned Meristem, who did all the playground and perimeter planting, to design and, funding willing, install planting in the basement outside area. This will then be an additional reading area in good weather and an attractive outside teaching space.

**Air Quality.** The Governors and I am in consultation with Westminster and The Greater London Authority to plan possible strategies to improve the quality of the air the children and staff breathe, including an exciting pilot to "clean" the air within and outside the school.
