As an outstanding Church of England school, St Peter's offers children the chance to achieve excellence within a Christian environment.

We aim to create a happy school with equal opportunities for all - a special place where a sense of curiosity is nurtured and a solid foundation of skills and understanding is built to help St Peter's children become life long learners.

St Peter's children develop a sense of independence and confidence to tackle challenges. While also building an understanding of responsibility, community commitment and kindness to others.

The first mention of a St Peter's School was in 1815. A survey carried out between the years 1864-7 by the National Society for Promoting Religious Education described a school for children of Infant age whose building stood in Eccleston Place facing Phipps' Mews.

The present building was erected in 1872 on a site given by the Marquess of Westminster to the Vicar and Churchwardens of St Peter's Church. In 1949 and following the 1944 Education Act the school assumed its present form and became a Junior Mixed and Infants' School.

The School now accommodates 300 full-time primary and 10 part-time nursery children between three and eleven years of age in thirteen classes.

Admissions procedures

Parents of children whose date of birth falls between 1st September 2014 and the last day in August 2015 inclusive are invited to make an application to our Reception class for September 2019. All supplementary admission forms and admission criteria can be found on our website.

50 full time pupils will be admitted to the Reception class.

New applications must be lodged for a Reception place even if there has been an earlier application for a Nursery place. There is no automatic transfer between Nursery and Reception.

The deadline for Reception/Nursery Applications is 15 January 2019.

Places will be offered on 16 April 2019.

School Results

The school provides excellent teaching and learning and pupils have consistently high achievement, placing the school well within the top 5% nationally.

The percentage of pupils at St Peter's making and exceeding expected progress in reading, writing and maths is significantly above national figures.

HOME LEARNING

We have replaced the setting of traditional homework with home learning to complement a child's progress at school. This encourages pupils to develop skills, confidence and motivation needed to study effectively on their own. It consolidates skills and understanding developed at school, while sustaining positive parental involvement.
