This coming Sunday is the last Sunday before Lent when we focus on Christ's Transfiguration – a moment of glory that he had with his closest disciples before his face was set resolutely towards Jerusalem. Lent is almost upon us with Ash Wednesday next week (5th March). The word Lent is derived from an old English word meaning “the lengthening of days” or the “springtime of the year”. 9.15 am School Eucharist in Church with imposition of ashes

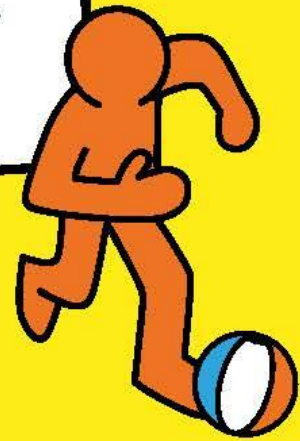
12.30 pm Holy Eucharist (said) with imposition of ashes
