Dear parents and carers

It was lovely to have the school in St Peter's Church for the Ash Wednesday Mass this week which begins the season of Lent in preparation for Easter. A number of children in school are observing Ramadan with their families at the same time and it has been good to talk about the similarities between Ramadan and Lent.

This coming Sunday is the first Sunday in Lent when we think about the forty days and forty nights during which Jesus went into the desert. We will reflect on how in the desert we relearn our awareness on our dependence on God, the source and origin of all life and love and our gratitude for it. Our word "Lent" is derived from an old-English word meaning literally the "lengthening of days". In our part of the world Lent coincides with spring as new life and colour break forth again from the earth. 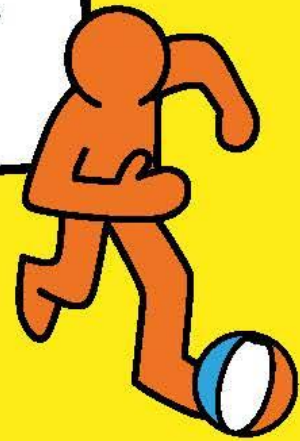
