Dear parents and carers,

This week at the School Mass it was lovely to be able to talk about Maundy Thursday, when Jesus washed his disciples' feet and shared the Last Supper with them before they went to the Garden of Gethsemane. As part of my talk, 12 children joined Jesus around the altar to create a tableau of the Last Supper. The word "Maundy" is derived from the Latin "mandatum novum" - the new commandment that Jesus gave his friends and disciples that they are to love one another just as he loves us. That same quality of reconciled love should characterise our church and school communities as we build each other up in love.

Next Thursday School Mass will be in Church, when we will explore what happened on Good Friday and how Jesus opens wide his arms to draw the whole world to his heart of love. You would be really welcome to join us for School Mass and you are warmly welcome at all our services and activities - especially our 0930 Family Eucharist.

This Sunday is Mothering Sunday when we give thanks for all who nurture and care for children, Mary the mother of Jesus and our mother, the Church, which loves and cares for all and draws everyone to the fire of God's love.
