Dear parents and carers,

It's been a very full week at school with our Year 6s doing their SATS, Ofsted Inspectors in, the School Mass and preparing twelve of our children for confirmation by Bishop Rob Wickham this coming Sunday. We are really proud at the way in which our wonderful children and inspirational staff have navigated this week in our school community, which we know to be a nurturing and truly inclusive place.
