Greetings from St Peter's Church

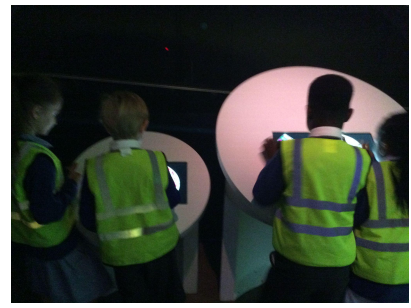
Dear parents and carers

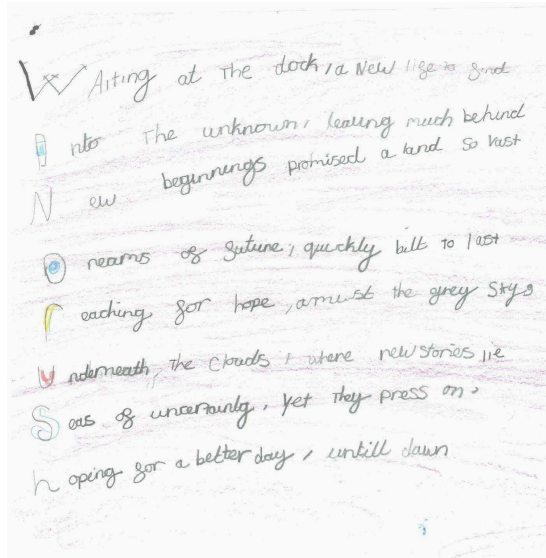
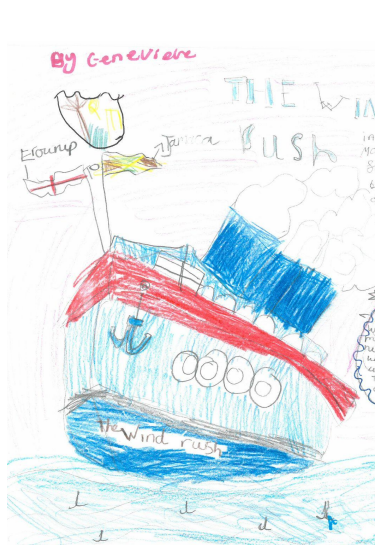

This year's committee members are: **Nehemiah, Luke, Isla, Timotei, Sophia,** and **Zhenya.**

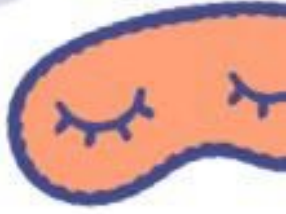
We're so proud of the thoughtful and responsible way they've stepped into this role, and we look forward to seeing the positive impact they'll make this year!
