### Greetings from St Peter's Church

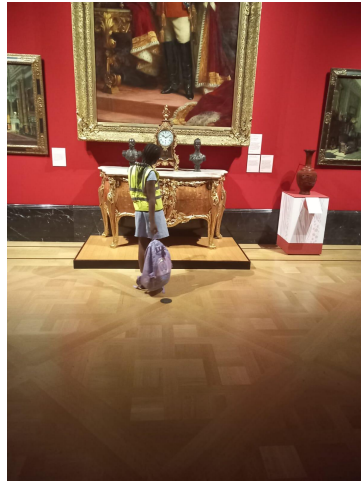
From Fr Jonathan - Vicar of St Peter's Church
