Greetings from St Peter's Church

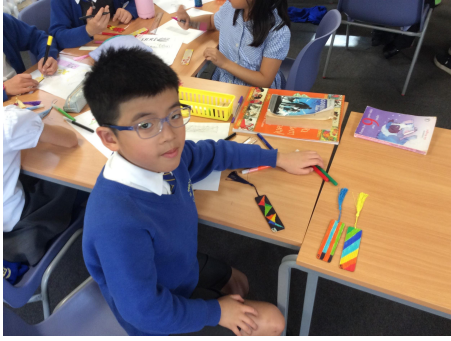
Dear parents and carers

It was lovely to preside at the first School Mass of the new school year in St Peter's Church yesterday morning. As our Gospel reading we had the parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37) in which our school vision is rooted and grounded in the words "love thy neighbour"
