At School Mass yesterday we looked at Jesus' first miracle in the transformation of water into wine at the wedding in Cana of Galilee (John 2:1-11). It was his first miracle and through it his glory is revealed and his disciples believed in him.

This coming Sunday at St Peter's Church we celebrate the Conversion of St Paul from being one of the fiercest opponents and persecutors of the followers of Jesus to being one of the greatest means by which the Gospel of God's inclusive and generous love was transmitted to the world. Lord in your mercy.

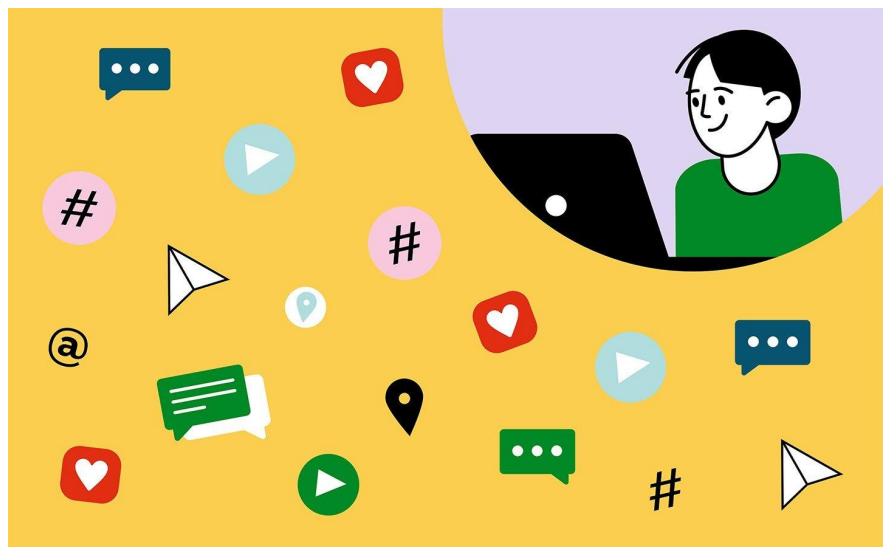
Yr 4 RE Learning this week
