## Yr 1 & 2 met a Beekeeper



Today at Forest School, we had a very exciting visit from a real beekeeper! The children learned all about bees and why they are so important for our world.

We discovered that bees help plants grow by spreading pollen, which helps fruits and flowers develop. The children were amazed to learn that a queen bee can lay thousands of eggs and that worker bees collect nectar to make honey.

We also learned how beekeepers look after their hives and keep the bees safe. The children had the chance to look closely at beekeeping equipment and asked some fantastic questions.

It was a wonderful hands-on experience that helped us learn more about nature and how we can help protect bees.
