Dear parents and carers,

It was lovely to celebrate the end of term Mass in Church this morning when we thought about all that Christians remember on **Good Friday**. Here at St Peter's Church Holy Week begins this Sunday with **Palm Sunday** (29th March) and you are warmly welcome at our 9.30 am Family Eucharist followed by our lovely annual palm procession around Eaton Square.

Throughout Holy Week, you are also warmly welcome at our Choral Eucharist of the Lord's Supper on **Maunder Thursday** (April 2nd) at 7 pm and at our **Good Friday** (April 3rd) children's service at 10 am. On Holy Saturday (April 4th) at 8 pm we have the Easter Vigil which begins around a new fire in the churchyard and we bring the Easter candle into the darkness of the Church at the beginning of beautiful service.

Then on **Easter Day** (April 5th) we have all our services at the usual times celebrating the risen Christ, including our Family Eucharist at 9.30 am.

Bani: We learned about Easter and how Jesus died on the cross to forgive our sins. We also learned about Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. Maundy Thursday was when Jesus and his disciples shared what we now call Holy Communion – bread and wine. After they ate and drank, Jesus washed the disciples' feet. Peter tried to refuse, but Jesus did it anyway. Good Friday is when Jesus was crucified on the cross. During Easter, in churches, all the decorations are removed, sombre music is played, and readings are shared about what Jesus taught his disciples. This all happens during Holy Week.
