Our family service returns to 930am this Sunday to which you are all very welcome. The gospel passage for Sunday encourages us that there is room for all in God's kingdom.

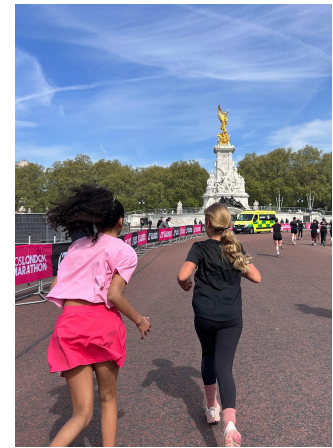
