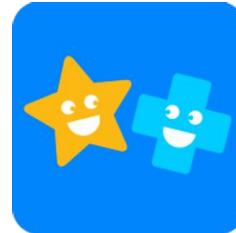
The class with the lowest attendance is: 4 Buckingham with 93.75%
