Dear St Peter's Families,

Thank you to all of our families for your support and understanding this week as we managed the exceptionally hot weather. Keeping our children and staff safe and comfortable has been our priority.

As many of you know, St Peter's is a beautiful Victorian building in the heart of London, but it can become extremely warm during periods of high temperatures. Whilst we do have air conditioning in parts of the school, it is ageing, less effective than it once was and some units are now leaking.

Like over 1,000 schools across England and Wales, we adapted our arrangements this week. We remained open until 1.00pm each day, ensuring children continued with their learning, enjoyed lunch together and received home learning for the afternoon. Supervision also remained available for any families who required it.

Replacing our air conditioning system is currently beyond our budget. If anyone in our community is aware of funding opportunities or businesses that may be able to support us, we would love to hear from you. It may even be a wonderful project for our PTA to champion in the future.

Thank you once again for your continued support. We hope you have a lovely weekend, stay safe in the sunshine, and we look forward to seeing you all at next Friday's Summer Fair!

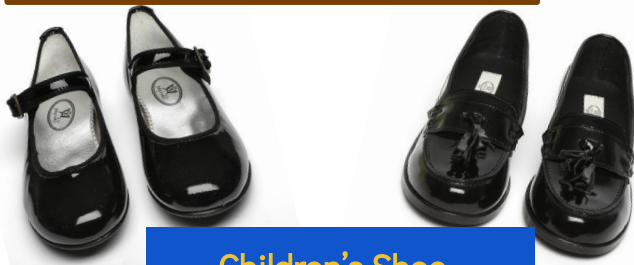
